

# Potts Run Passive Treatment System

## INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

**PROJECT SUMMARY:** The Potts Run passive system will be constructed on a coal refuse pile adjacent to Potts Run in Knox Township, Clearfield County. The project will install two vertical flow ponds (VFPs) that will treat acid mine drainage flowing from abandoned mines. The project involves collection and piping of two discharges, construction of two VFPs with synthetic liners and containing 7,500 tons limestone and 1850 CY of mushroom compost, 2,200 tons alkaline amendment to the coal refuse, and revegetation of the site.

**INSURANCE:** The contractor will provide a Certificate of Insurance showing a minimum of \$2 million in general liability and workman's compensation insurance.

**BONDING:** A 5% bid bond is required. The contractor will be required to post a performance and materials bond.

**FUNDING** Trout Unlimited is working via a pass-through contract with the PA DEP Bureau of Abandoned Mine Reclamation and is subject to the Commonwealth's Prevailing Wage requirements. The project is fully funded.

**PROJECT TIMELINE:** Work should begin by the end of September 2018. Substantial completion of the project by Dec 1, 2018. Final completion by May 1, 2019.
