

**Railroad Run AMD Project
McKean County Conservation District
Norwich Township McKean County
Construction Narrative and Bid Information
July 8, 2019**

INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

- 1. PROJECT INFORMATION.** This project involves the construction of two separate passive mine water treatment systems: RR18D and RR19D.
- 2. BIDS DUE.** BIDS will be received by MCCD until 4:00 PM on July 29, 2019. A complete BID consists of the completed BID FORM, a 10% bid bond, and a 1-page description of prior experience on this type of project.
- 3. BID DELIVERY.** BIDS will only be accepted by mail or in person.

If accepted, a signed copy of the original bid and bonding must be provided.
- 4. MANDATORY MEETING.** All BIDDERS must attend a pre-bid meeting at the site on July 18, 2019. The pre-bid meeting will begin at 10 AM at Railroad Run construction access road entrance to Open Flow Gas at 192 Colegrove Brook Road, Crosby PA. Pre-register by contacting MCCD at (814)887-4003 or accauser@mckeancountypa.org by July 16, 2019.
- 5. BID FORM.** The BID shall be submitted on the enclosed Bid Form and completed in total. Copies of the bid form may be used, but only one copy per sealed bid may be submitted. The BID should reflect the cost of completing the entire project. The owner, president, or other controlling officer of the company must sign the bid form. This signature indicates that all aspects of this bid document, including the attached plans, have been reviewed.
- 6. REJECTED BIDS.** BIDS received after the scheduled closing time will be rejected. McKean County Conservation District reserves the right to waive any and all informalities in the BID and to reject any or all bids.
- 7. BID OPENING.** BIDS will be opened on July 29, 2019 at 4:00 PM and are open to the public.
- 8. SELECTION CRITERIA.** The SUCCESSFUL BIDDER will be selected on the basis of total bid price for construction of both treatment systems, proof of insurance and bonding, previous

experience and ability to complete the project in the given time period. The SUCCESSFUL BIDDER will be notified by July 30, 2019.

- 9. PROOF OF INSURANCE.** The successful BIDDER will provide an insurance certificate that shows at least \$1,000,000 of general liability insurance and Workman's Compensation. The successful BIDDER will name McKean County Conservation District as an additional insured.
- 10. WAGES.** This project is funded by the PA Department of Environmental Protection and is subject to the Commonwealth's Prevailing Wage requirements. A copy of the wage report provided by the Department of Labor and Industry is available from MCCD.
- 11. BONDING.** Each Bid must be guaranteed with a 10% Bid Bond. Evidence of the Bid Bond should accompany the Bid. Road bonds are responsibility of the bidder.
- 12. CLEARANCE BY DEP.** All contractors and subcontractors involved in the project must be approved by PADEP. The SUCCESSFUL BIDDER will provide its Federal Employee Identification Number (FEIN) and the FEIN of any subcontractors.
- 13. COMMENCEMENT OF WORK.** Work shall begin no later than August 1, 2019. The project must be completed by September 30, 2019.
